Palazzo Flanzini

Synthesis between the Art of Past and Future

This noble Palace is a clear expression of the Venetian baroque, today perfectly restored. It is the ideal location for Art's Lovers thanks to its Murano contemporary candeliers that make the atmosphere a perfect fusion between the Art of Past and Future.

Its total 1000 square meters host a ground floor (Fondaco Floor) and a first floor (Piano Nobile) perfect for customized events as weddings (even intimate ones) exhibitions and business dinners and meetings.

Palazzo Flangini overlooks the Grand Canal and has completely independent water and inland entrances. It is located nearby Santa Lucia railway station.

Palazzo Pisani


Palazzo Pisani, the second biggest noble Palace of Venice

Since 1876 it hosts the Conservatory of Venice "Benedetto Marcello", that makes this Palace even more romantic for all those who like to have their wedding or event in a "musical atmosphere".

It is perfect for all big events where guests can dance in the ground floor.

The palace offers two noble floors, several rooms along its wings, a big concert room, a bright resershal studio, a breath-taking terrace - the highest of the cityable to host up to 100 people and two internal courts. It is easy reacheable by boat from the Grand Canal but has also two entrances from Campo Santo Stefano.













Luxurious location for majestic events and weddings in the historic centre.

Scriola Grande della Misericordia

One of the six "Scuola Grande", very large halls for majestic weddings and events

Located in the historical centre the Scuola Grande della Misericordia hosts two of the largests halls of Venice. Fully renewed, with a total area of 2000 sqm and its original frescoes, this is a very good choice for big and luxury weddings, for very big installations or decorations. It is the most suitable location to host up to

The First Floor

In the first floor there is the second largest hall of Venice historic centre - after Sala del Maggior Consiglio" in Palazzo Ducale - enhaced by **Paolo Veronese's rich frescoes.**

The Ground Floor

The big hall is composed by three naves with columns in Corinthia style. There are three entrances: two for the guests and the third for staff use only.













A Garden Terrace overlooking the Gran Canal

Palazzo Benzon is the most suitable location to enjoy the historical atmosphere in a Venetian palace, located in the most privileged position on the Grand Canal between the Rialto and the Accademia bridges, close to S.Marco's Square.

The Main Hall was an exclusive meeting point for memorable parties: the living room animated by Marina Querini Benzon was often attended by nobles, ambassadors and writers such as Lord Byron and Casanova.

The "Piano Nobile" and its six connected rooms are promptly decorated with ancient frescoes and stuccos, stretches across the floor. They are a perfect complement for weddings and events aimed at involving all your senses.

The garden terrace overlooks Palazzo Fortuny thanks to a large balcony on the Grand Canal.



A Palladian Villa in the wineyard hills of Veneto

Villa Gordellina Lon-bardi

A huge Palladian Villa close to Vicenza, in the wineyard hills of the Veneto Region

In 1735 the architect Massari projected Villa Cordellina, also called "Lombardi", from the commissioner family. In 1743 Tiepolo painted the frescoes inspired by Scipione The African and Alessandro Magno's achievements.

Nowadays Villa Cordellina, entirely restored, is a perfect fusion between tradition and modernity, thanks to its outdoor and indoor spaces evocating different moods.

There are several available spaces: Tiepolo Room, Vetrate Room, two side porticos, a rustic entirely renewed including a lounge area able to host the catering service, a wide central courtyard, next to a smaller one and wonderful gardens.
